Eligible for one (1) Award of Merit *HB* pg. 41

Eligible for the Lemon Bay Garden Club Crystal Dish

Single stem or spray per exhibit. Include foliage only if attached on the stem of the specimen.

Stem length shall be in good proportion to the size of the bloom.

Section M. "Butterscotch Blondies"

Combination Planting *HB pg. 59*

Eligible for one (1) Grower's Choice Award *HB pg. 41*

A grouping of three (3) or more botanically different plants with similar cultural requirements. Containers must weigh less than 20 pounds and the container must not exceed 14" as measured across the top. Naturalistic accessories are permitted if in scale with plants and container, and theme appropriate to the plants. Each specimen must be correctly identified on a 3" x 5" card by the current scientific designation and in a manner to easily identify the specimen's location in the container.

- Class:
1. Planter -- a grouping of plants in an indoor or outdoor container.
 2. Dish Garden -- miniature landscape in an open low-volume shallow container.
 3. Combination Planter (all plants chosen for use in a recipe of the grower's choice. Recipe on a 4" x 6" card must be included).
